

Moshe as a Commercial Redemption Metaphor

This is my thoughts about the life of Moshe and how it metaphorically fits with concepts in the law of commerce

- Valley of death: When Israel walks through the red sea which has a wall of water on both sides, did not Israel walk through this water, a valley of death, without fear? (See below Psa 23 below)
- What is the meaning of Moshe's name? to draw out. Out of what?...water (Exo 2:10). One can be "mikvahed" / baptized in water for the purpose of eternal life and one can also drown in water, therefore water is a metaphor for life and death and is dependent on how one uses/abuses it.
- Moshe survived in his wicker basket vessel i.e. his redemption was to use the commercial term vessel (think straw man). YHVH did his job of protecting Moshe by using a commercial remedy.
- Since Moshe was put on the water what law form presided...Equity/Admiralty/Maritime?
- Did not Moshe's mother follow the orders of the Pharaoh by "throwing" her son in the river, so she therefore remained in honor?
- Like the birth certificate, was she not the mother who was the "informant" i.e. the snitch "who done sold her son down the river" Gary L. Sund talked about this when explaining how to fill out the UCC1 form (see 1:22:50) The birth certificate identifies the mother as the informant who pledges her child to the state. This was not his intent, but my analytical gears were turning so I put the two thoughts together.
- Exodus also talks about those Hebrew mid-wives and how they were an impediment from keeping the Israelites from checking into Pharaoh's state run hospitals.
- Just a thought, but could the wicker basket have been covered in pitch similar to the Ark which was covered by pitch (Gen 6:14). The Hebrew word for pitch is kaphar which, using edenics, is where we get the English word cover. Kaphar is also translated in the KJ as atonement; think Yom Kippur the day of atonement when Elohim has you covered.
- Moshe's mother got her son back to care for him and she got paid by the State to boot! What man (Pharaoh) intended for evil (sacrificing the son's of Israel to the false god of the Nile) YHVH uses for good (blessing Moshe's mother for following instructions and remaining in honor).

Psa 23:1-6 KJV <A Psalm of David.> YHVH *is* my shepherd; I shall not want. ² He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. ³ He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. ⁴ **Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil:** for thou *art* with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. ⁵ Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. ⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of YHVH for ever.

Exo 2:2-3 KJV And the woman conceived, and bare a son: and when she saw him that he *was a* goodly^{H2896} ^T_{ov, (J&T, enlarged Tet)} *child*, she hid him three months. ³ And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark^{H8392} *tebah* of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with ^{H2203} *zepeth* and put the child therein; and she laid *it* in the flags^{H5488} *suph* by the river's brink.

JKM Thoughts: For your Security Agreement to mature and be perfected you need to wait 90 days i.e. 3 months (one of the meanings of 3 is perfection). The same word for Ark is also used in Gen 6:14. Also in Gen 6:14 the same word in English is used for pitch but, unfortunately, it's not the same Hebrew word.
