

and I will commune with thee from above the kapporet, from between the two keruvim which are upon the Aron HaEdut, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the Bnei Yisroel. <sup>23</sup> Thou shalt also make a Shulchan of acacia wood; two cubits shall be the length thereof, and a cubit the width thereof, and a cubit and a half the height thereof. <sup>24</sup> And thou shalt overlay it with zahav tavor, and make thereto a crown of zahav around. <sup>25</sup> And thou shalt make unto it a border of a handbreadth round about, and thou shalt make a golden crown on the rim thereof round about. <sup>26</sup> And thou shalt make for it four rings of zahav, and place the rings in the four corners that are on the four legs thereof. <sup>27</sup> Over against the rim shall the rings be for holders of the poles to carry the Shulchan. <sup>28</sup> And thou shalt make the poles of acacia wood, and overlay them with zahav, that the Shulchan may be carried with them. <sup>29</sup> And thou shalt make the dishes thereof, and spoons thereof, and shelving-tubes thereof, and bowls thereof, with which it shall be used to pour libations; of zahav tavor shalt thou make them. <sup>30</sup> And thou shalt set upon the Shulchan the Lechem Panim before Me always. <sup>31</sup> And thou shalt make a Menorah of zahav tavor; hammered out shall the Menorah be made; its base, its shaft, and its cups, its knobs, and its blossoms, shall be of the same. <sup>32</sup> And six branches shall come out of the sides of it; three branches of the menorah out of the one side, and three branches of the menorah out of the other side; <sup>33</sup> Three cups engraved with almonds on the one branch, a knob and a flower; and three cups made like almonds in the other branch, with a knob and a flower; so for the six branches that come out of the Menorah. <sup>34</sup> And on the Menorah shall be four cups engraved like almonds, its knobs and its flowers. <sup>35</sup> And there shall be a knob under two branches of the same, and a knob under two branches of the same, and a knob under two branches of the same, according to the six branches that proceed out of the Menorah. <sup>36</sup> Their knobs and their branches shall be of the same; all of it shall be one hammered out work of zahav tavor. <sup>37</sup> And thou shalt make the nerot shivah thereof; and they shall kindle the nerot thereof, that they may give light toward its face. <sup>38</sup> And the tongs thereof, and the spoons thereof, shall be of zahav tavor. <sup>39</sup> Of a talent of zahav tavor shall he make it, with all these vessels. <sup>40</sup> And see that thou make them after their tavnit, which was shown thee in HaHar.

**Exodus 25** <sup>1</sup> And Hashem spoke unto Moshe, saying, <sup>2</sup> Speak unto the Bnei Yisroel, that they bring Me a tarmah (offering); of every man that giveth it willingly with his lev ye shall receive My tarmah (offering). <sup>3</sup> And this is the tarmah (offering) which ye shall receive of them; zahav, and kesef, and nechoshet, <sup>4</sup> and tunpoise, and purple, and scarlet wool, and linen, and goat hair, <sup>5</sup> and ram skins dyed red, and tachash skins, and acacia wood, <sup>6</sup> Shemen for the light, spices for shemen hamishchah (anointing oil) and aromatical ketoret (incense), <sup>7</sup> Choshan stone, and stones to be set in the Ephod, and in the Choshan (Breastplate). <sup>8</sup> And let them make Me a Mikdash; that I may dwell among them. <sup>9</sup> According to all that I show thee, after the tavnit HaYitshkan (according to the Tabernacle), and the tavnit of all the vessels thereof, even so shall ye make it. <sup>10</sup> And they shall make an Aron (Ark) of acacia wood, two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the width thereof, and the height thereof. <sup>11</sup> And they shall build chambers against all the Beis [HaMikdash], five cubits high; and they rested on the Beis [HaMikdash] with timber of cedars. <sup>12</sup> And they shall build chambers against all the Beis [HaMikdash], five cubits high; and they shall build the Beis [HaMikdash], and finished it; and covered the Beis [HaMikdash] with beams and boards of cedars. <sup>13</sup> And then he shall enter into the middle chamber, and out of the middle into the third (chamber) for provision for his Beis, and twenty kor of shemen kaneh (olive oil); thus gave Sh'lomo to Chitram shanah b'shanah. <sup>14</sup> And Sh'lomo gave Chitram twenty thousand kor of chittim (wheat) for provision for his Beis, and twenty kor of shemen kaneh (olive oil); thus gave Sh'lomo to Chitram shanah b'shanah. <sup>15</sup> (G:12) And Hashem gave Sh'lomo chochmah, just as He promised him; and there was shalom between Chitram and Sh'lomo; and he spoke of ezrim (trees), from the ezor cedars tree that is in the Levanon even unto the ezov (myrtle) which grows out of the Beis [HaMikdash], and the mas was thirty thousand ish. <sup>16</sup> (G:14) And he sent them to the Levanon, ten thousand a month by chaliot (courses, shifts); a month they were in the Levanon, and two months they were b'Payit (at home); and Adadonam was in charge of the mas. <sup>17</sup> (G:15) And Sh'lomo had three score and ten thousand cutters in the har (mountains); <sup>18</sup> (G:16) This was in addition to the chief of Sh'lomo's Nizavim, who were over the project, three thousand three hundred, who supervised the people that wrought in the work. <sup>19</sup> (G:17) And Hattielech commanded, and avanim gedolot (great stones) (they quarried, costly stones, to lay the foundation of the Bayit with hewn stones. <sup>20</sup> (G:18) And the Bont Gevati and Bontei Chitram did chisel them, and the men from Sh'lomo; so they prepared ezrim (timber) and avanim (stones) to build the Bayit (the Beis HaMikdash). [See Ps 118:22 and Isa 53]. <sup>21</sup> And it came to pass in the fourth hundred and eightieth year after the Bnei Yisroel were come out of Eretz Mitzrayim, in the fourth year of Sh'lomo's reign over Yisroel, in the month Ziv, which is the second month, that he began to build the Beis Hashem. <sup>22</sup> And the Beis [HaMikdash] which king Sh'lomo built for Hashem, the length thereof was threescore cubits, and the breadth thereof twenty cubits, and the height thereof thirty cubits. <sup>23</sup> And the Ulam (Portico) in front of the Heikhal of the Beis [HaMikdash], twenty cubits was the length thereof, and the breadth thereof twenty cubits, and the height thereof thirty cubits. <sup>24</sup> And the Ulam (Portico) in front of the Heikhal of the Beis [HaMikdash], twenty cubits was the length thereof, according to the breadth of the Beis [HaMikdash], and ten cubits was the breadth thereof projecting in front of the Beis [HaMikdash]. <sup>25</sup> And for the Beis [HaMikdash] he made embarsures. <sup>26</sup> And against the wall of the Beis [HaMikdash] he built chambers round about, against the walls of the Beis [HaMikdash] round about, both of the Heikhal and of the Debir; and he made chambers round about; <sup>27</sup> The lowest story was five cubits broad, and the middle was six cubits broad, and the third was seven cubits broad; and round about, that the beams should not be fastened in the walls of the Beis [HaMikdash]. <sup>28</sup> And the Beis [HaMikdash], when it was under construction, was built of stone made ready before it was brought thence; and he shomer over all My Mizvot, and executed My Yiduvanim, and he shomer over all My Mizvot, and in them; then will I perform My word (promise) upon you, and you shall dwell in the land which I swore unto your tosh, for you are not able to make one har (footsold) of his lev, nor by Yenusahayim, for it is the kindat Hashem (throne of G-d). <sup>29</sup> Nor by haazer, for it is the hadom (goats) at all, neither by Shomayim, for it is the kes malchut of Hashem (throne of G-d). <sup>30</sup> But I say to you, Do not swear shevot (oaths) at all, neither by Shomayim, for it is the kes malchut of Hashem (throne of G-d). <sup>31</sup> See VAYIKRA 19:12; BAMBIBAR (Testimony [of Tablets]) And thou shalt make a kapporet of zahav tavor, two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the width thereof, and thou shalt make the kapporet of the two ends of the kapporet, and the other keruv on the other end, with the keruvim of zahav, of beaten work shalt thou make them, in the two ends of the kapporet. <sup>32</sup> And make one keruv on the two ends thereof, covering the kapporet with their wings, and their wings upward, covering the kapporet with their wings, and their faces of the keruvim be. <sup>33</sup> And thou shalt place the kapporet on the Aron from above; and into the Aron thou shalt place the Edut that I shall give thee. <sup>34</sup> And there I will meet with thee, and I will dwell among them, and I will forsake My people Yisroel.

**26** <sup>1</sup> Moreover thou shalt make the Mishkan (Tabernacle) with ten curtains of twisted linen with turquoise, purple, and scarlet wool; with keruvim of artistic needle work shalt thou make them. <sup>2</sup> The length of one curtain shall be eight and twenty cubits, and the width of one curtain four cubits; and every one of the curtains shall have middah achat (one size). <sup>3</sup> The five curtains shall be choverot (joined together) one to another; and the other five curtains shall be chovrot one to another. <sup>4</sup> And thou shalt make loops of turquoise wool upon the edge of the outermost curtain of the set; and likewise shalt thou make loops upon the edge of the outermost curtain, in the second set. <sup>5</sup> Fifty loops shalt thou make in the first curtain, and fifty loops shalt thou make on the edge of the outermost curtain that is in the second set; that the loops may be opposite one another. <sup>6</sup> And thou shalt make fifty hooks of zahav, and join the curtains together with the hooks: so that the Mishkan shall become one. <sup>7</sup> And thou shalt make curtains of goat hair to be an Ohel over the Mishkan: eleven curtains shalt thou make. <sup>8</sup> The length of one curtain shall be thirty cubits, the width of one curtain four cubits; and the eleven curtains shall be all of the middah achat (same size). <sup>9</sup> And thou shalt join into one five curtains by themselves, and six curtains by themselves, and shalt fold the sixth curtain over the front of the Ohel. <sup>10</sup> And thou shalt make fifty loops along the edge of the first curtain at the end of one choveret (set), and fifty loops on the edge of the curtain of the second choveret (set). <sup>11</sup> And thou shalt make fifty hooks of nechoshet, and put the hooks into the loops, and attach the Ohel, so that it may become ehad (one). <sup>12</sup> And the remnant of the overhang of the curtains of the Ohel, half of the curtain that remaineth, shall hang over the back of the Mishkan. <sup>13</sup> And a cubit on the one side, and a cubit on the other side of that which remaineth in the length of the curtains of the Ohel, shall hang over the sides of the Mishkan on this side and the other, to cover it. <sup>14</sup> And thou shalt make a Mikhseh for the Ohel of ram skins dyed red, and a Mikhseh of tachash skins above. <sup>15</sup> And thou shalt make the kerashim (planks) of the Mishkan of acacia wood, standing erect. <sup>16</sup> Ten cubits shall be the length of each keresh (plank), and a cubit and a half shall be the width of each keresh (plank). <sup>17</sup> Two yadot (tenons, projections) shall there be in each keresh (plank), set in order one against another: thus shalt thou make for all the kerashim (planks) of the Mishkan. <sup>18</sup> And thou shalt make the kerashim (planks) for the Mishkan,
